The **10th edition** of the CIREN Workshop organized by the “Electrical Engineers Association of the Montefiore Institute” (AIM) will be held for the first time in Belgium, in the dynamic city of **Brussels**. Belgium is at the heart of the **CIREN history** as it is where the first ever edition of the CIREN main conference took place.
