2.2. Extra registrations

2.3. Included booth personalization

Personalised logo display

The required dimensions are 1000 mm (W) × 1466 mm (H) (100 cm × 146.6 cm) in pdf. Please upload your artwork via the “uploader” folder **by 13 May**. Your personal link for the “uploader folder” will be sent to you in February 2026, or, if you register after this date, a few days following confirmation of



your booking. The link will be sent by Ayah Ram (ar@alterexpo.be). If you do not receive it, please contact her to request that it be sent again.

Technical information :

- Graphic print: format 100 x 146,6 cm (adhesive)
- PDF file, using CMYK colors
- 2 cm bleed and 2 cm text margin on each side (at full size)
- Scale 1:1 (minimum resolution 150 dpi)
- To be uploaded via “uploader” platform (deadline 13 May 2026) : You will receive, or may already have received, a personal link to the “uploader folder” (see above).
- Set all fonts to outlines and the text size to at least 12 pt

The visual can be fully customized by the exhibitor, provided it complies with the dimensions above.

3. During the event

3.1. Access Information

By Public Transport

The EGG Brussels is easily accessible from both Brussels Airport (BRU) and Brussels South Station using public transportation:

From Brussels International Airport (BRU):

Take the train from Brussels Airport to Brussels South Station (Bruxelles-Midi). Trains run every 10 minutes, and the journey takes approximately 20 minutes.

At Brussels South Station, exit the station via Rue de France and follow the route for approximately 10 minutes on foot.

From Brussels South Station (Bruxelles-Midi):

The EGG Brussels is conveniently located within walking distance from Brussels South Station. Exit the station via Rue de France and follow the route for approximately 10 minutes on foot.

By Taxi or Rideshare

For a more direct option, taxis and rideshare services (Uber, Bolt) are available from both Brussels Airport and Brussels South Station:

A taxi from Brussels Airport to The EGG takes around 25 minutes, depending on traffic.

From Brussels South Station, a short 5-minute taxi or rideshare ride will get you to the venue quickly.

- **June 10:** 16:45 – 17:30

Pickup on 11 June (Small Items)

(located behind the welcome desk and accessible from the corridor)

Important:

If large items must remain at the venue for pickup on 11 June, they must be stored in the Grand Hall (Poster Room) and not in Riverside (Exhibition Room).

3.5. Parking

Delivery / unloading

If you need to park temporarily to deliver materials, you may use The EGG's parking at Rue Bara **173**, 1070 Brussels. Please note that this parking is for delivery only and cars cannot remain parked there after unloading.

During the event

You may park in the streets near the venue. Please note that on-street parking is paid. We recommend using a parking app (4411, EasyPark, or Seety).

You can also use public paid car parks nearby. The closest one is Q-Park (Rue Bara), approximately 7 minutes' walk from the venue.

Each exhibitor booth includes:

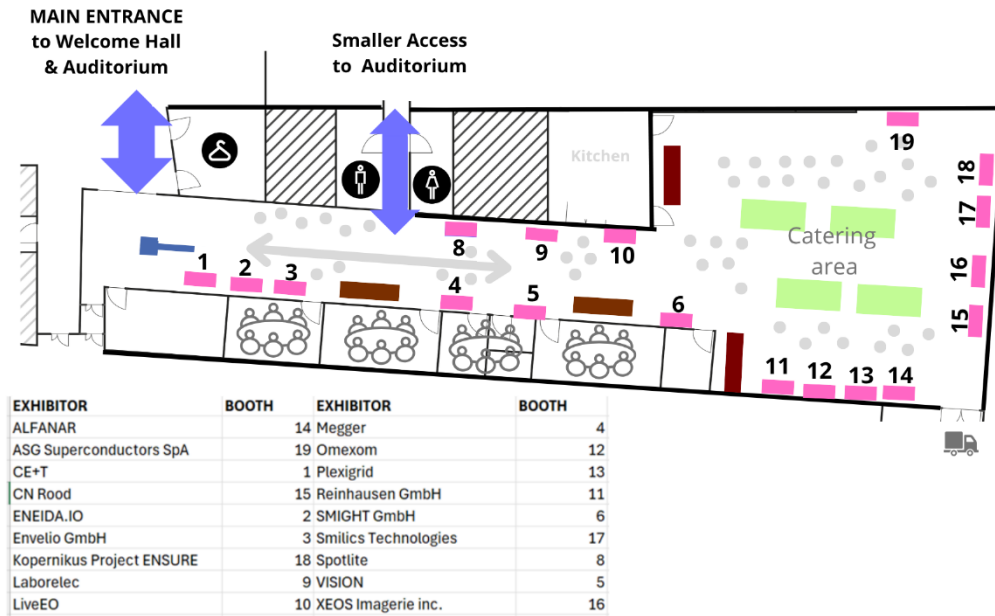
- **Space:** 2m x 3m
